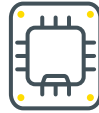
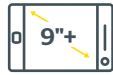

THE BASICS



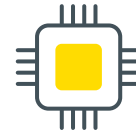
Screen

Must be comfortable for all day use



Storage

Windows or OSX minimum 128GB
Chrome minimum 32GB



RAM

Windows or OSX **at least** 8GB
Chrome 4GB is suitable



Battery life

Ideally 8 hours to last through the whole day at school



Weight

Look for small and light devices to make it easy for your child to carry



Mil spec

These devices are purpose built, with a rugged chassis, water resistant keyboard and stronger hinges

EXTRA INVESTMENTS



Protective case

Reduce the risk of damage, and help extend the life of your device.



Damage protection plan

for the ultimate peace of mind, you'll have everything covered especially those unfortunate accidents



External keyboard

Use an external keyboard with a tablet for increased comfort and productivity



Touch screens

Supports different modes including drawing and hand writing with a stylus



Stylus

Supports drawing and handwriting which helps improve memory retention
